Week 1

Our RE topic to finish the year is all about the world and how we can care for God's creation. We know that a lot of you are very passionate about looking after the world and caring for it in different ways, so we hope you enjoy the activities provided for the next 7 weeks.

For many people, some places in the world are special. For others the whole world is special. We all feel a need to look after what is special to us. Sometimes it is easy to explain why things are special. At other times it might be difficult to put into words why something is special.



Activity ideas: (complete as many as you like)

- Create a poster about things in the world that are special to you.
- Can you recall a time when your 'special place' was damaged or hurt? Write a diary entry with the feelings you experienced.
- Complete some research on Greta Thunberg and her international youth movement about climate change – why do you think she does this? What beliefs influence her?
- Have you been part of any environmental group? E.g. The BEAT team or Earth Guardians. Why are you part of this? What beliefs influence and encourage you to act this way?
- Challenge – Read the quote and write your own personal response about what it means to you. "God created the world to show and communicate his glory: that his creatures should share in his truth, goodness and beauty – this is the glory for which God created them".
- Art – Look out the window and draw the wonderful creations and special places that you can see.
