Bowes Museum Visit

This week Class Tees pupils had a wonderful visit to Bowes Museum. The visit was a mixture of history and art with the class learning printing techniques as well as learning about the history behind Bowes Museum. It as a fabulous opportunity for the children to see the art work and exhibitions currently on display.

All children have been learning about the floods in Pakistan and how they have impacted on the lives of over 33 million people- that's 1 in 7 of their population with families losing their homes livelihoods and, in some cases, loved ones.
